Overview

The Caval Ridge mine is the largest greenfield coal-mining complex in Australia located in the Bowen Basin of Central Queensland. Empower were contracted to deliver the mine infrastructure including pavements, roads, fuel farms, services and associated buildings required to service and assist with mining operations.

Project scope

Empower provided detailed design elements for facilities pads, (earthworks, offices, cribs, storage warehouses, fuel facilities) connecting roads, pavement designs for mine construction vehicles and creek crossings.
